APPROVAL OF AGENDA

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT

Joan O'Fallon shared the 2023 meeting calendar, 2023 board roster, thank-you notes from grant recipients and newspaper clips of check presentations from the past quarter. To increase the number of grant applications back to historical levels, the board asked Joan to promote that Operation Round Up is now accepting applications for spring grants.

MOTION TO APPROVE GRANT FUNDING

A motion was made by Herschel Brown and seconded by Clarice Johnson to approve \$9,000 in grant funding for seven nonprofit organizations below.

- 1. Amery School Agriculture Dept, \$1,500, install electricity in animal shed
- 2. Endeavors Adult Development Center, \$1,500, services for adults with disabilities
- 3. Unity FFA, \$1,000, animal gates and pens, and educational signage for Ag on the Lawn
- 4. Clear Lake Public Library, \$1,000, summer reading program
- 5. Ruby's Food Shelf, Home & Away Ministries, \$1,500, support food shelf in Siren area
- **6. Interfaith Caregivers of Polk County \$1,500,** recruit volunteers to help senior citizens and adults with disabilities
- 7. West Denmark Woodland School, \$1,000, summer school program for children
