Polk-Burnett is pleased to provide financial support to community programs through Operation Round-Up®. Funding for Operation Round-Up is donated by the member-owners of Polk-Burnett Electric Cooperative, who volunteer to round their monthly electric bill up to the next even dollar amount. The monies are combined and grants are awarded on a quarterly basis.

Recipients are selected by a committee of Polk-Burnett members, and contributions are *generally awarded* to non-profit programs, projects and organizations that improve the quality of life in our local communities *and* emphasize: public safety, health care, self-sufficiency, basic human needs, our cultural environment, community leadership and social issues for youth. Only one grant per year will be awarded to an organization.

Unless your project benefits the overall community, contributions are *generally not awarded* to: lobbying, political, religious, veteran or fraternal organizations; fundraising dinners, raffles or events; individuals; capital fund campaigns; scholarship programs; national fund drives or advertising.

ALL APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE a complete application package for consideration, including: an official application form, your most recent financial statement (a budget summary or balance sheet showing income and expenses specific to the project or program for which you are seeking grant funds) and documentation of tax-exempt status under the IRS Code Section 501(c)(3) or a letter of explanation regarding your tax-exempt status. If your organization has previously received an Operation Round-Up grant, the application requires that you give a detailed account of how the previous grant was used.

We invite you to apply for a grant if you meet our criteria. <u>Application deadlines are March 1, June 1, September 1 and December 1</u>. Please send the application to the address listed on the application form.

Dear Applicant:

We are pleased to inform you that upon review of your application for tax exempt status we have determined that you are exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Contributions to you are deductible under section 170 of the Code. You are also qualified to receive tax deductible bequests, devises, transfers or gifts under section 2055, 2106 or 2522 of the Code. Because this letter could help resolve any questions regarding your exempt status, you should keep it in your permanent records.

Organizations exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Code are further classified as either public charities or private foundations. During your advance ruling period, you will be treated as a public charity. Your advance ruling period begins with the effective date of your exemption and ends with advance ruling ending date shown in the heading of the letter.

Shortly before the end of your advance ruling period, we will send you Form 8734, Support Schedule for Advance Ruling Period. You will have 90 days after the end of your advance ruling period to return the completed form. We will then notify you, in writing, about your public charity status.

Please see enclosed Information for Exempt Organizations Under Section 501(c)(3) for some helpful information about your responsibilities as an exempt organization.

If you distribute funds to other organizations, your records must show whether they are exempt under section 501(c)(3). In cases where the recipient organization is not exempt under section 501(c)(3), you must have evidence the funds will be used for section 501(c)(3) purposes.

If you distribute funds to individuals, you should keep case histories showing the recipient's name and address; the purpose of the award; the manner of selection; and the relationship of the recipient to any of your officers, directors, trustees, members, or major contributors.
