## Subject: Disconnection & Reconnection Fees

Objective: To charge fees deemed sufficient to cover a part or all of Polk-Burnett's costs associated with the disconnection and reconnection of members under varying circumstances.

## Policy: 1. Collection Procedure

For any trip to the meter location for the purpose of collecting, disconnecting, or reconnecting for nonpayment, \$50 will be charged for each individual trip during regular working hours. After regular working hours, this fee will be \$100 for each individual trip per occurrence.

2. Requested Disconnection/Reconnection of Existing Electric Service

Any service disconnected or reconnected shall carry a fee of \$100 (\$100 paid at disconnection, \$100 paid upon reconnection).

3. Requested Disconnection/Reconnection of Foreclosed Accounts

Any request for disconnection from a member going through foreclosure will not be charged a disconnection fee provided the cooperative receives a verification of foreclosure. When the foreclosed location is being reconnected, a \$100 reconnection fee will apply.

4. Abnormal Situations

Whenever service has been disconnected for fraudulent use, non-compliance with established policies, disapproval of member's equipment, wiring installation or because of nuisance or hazardous conditions, etc., a charge deemed sufficient to cover the cost of disconnecting and reconnecting shall be paid before service is restored.
