Considering solar? We're here to help

Today's co-op members are looking for energy options. We know you want to power your homes with energy sources that are clean, efficient and cost-effective. I'm happy to report that electricity is becoming greener, and the cost for renewable energy is coming down. About 18% of the electricity we purchase for distribution to you is from renewable sources.

Beyond a greener grid, we also recognize that some of you are exploring residential solar as an alternative energy source. Interest in solar energy is fueled by decreasing costs for solar energy systems, the availability of tax incentives and rebates, and the growth of companies that offer solar panel installation. We're here to help: As attractive and popular as residential (rooftop) solar may appear, it is important to understand the true costs of installation and maintenance, as well as the true energy savings. To determine if residential solar is right for you, we encourage you to do your homework and ask yourself these questions:

| ☀️ How do you connect to the electric grid for power when the sun doesn't shine? | ☀️ Is it more cost-effective to invest in other energy saving measures for your home? |
